

Ina Drive closure extended to 1 February 2025

The NSW Government is investing \$110.2 million in the Cowra Hospital Redevelopment

Health Infrastructure has engaged Richard Crookes Constructions to undertake the main works for the Cowra Hospital Redevelopment.

We recognise that building new infrastructure can impact nearby residents, patients, staff and road users. All construction activities will be carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

Ina Drive closed (between Liverpool Lane and Carleton Street)

In order for a series of works to be undertaken in the coming months Ina Drive (between Liverpool Lane and Carleton Street) will be continue to be closed to vehicles until 1 February 2025. Pedestrian access will be available.

Access to the Emergency Department will be unchanged and still through Ina Drive via Liverpool Street or Liverpool Lane. Alternate vehicle access to Carleton Street and Upper Ina Drive will be via Darling Street.
