

Ina Drive and Brisbane Street pedestrian and vehicle access June-August 2024

The NSW Government is investing \$110.2 million in the Cowra Hospital Redevelopment

Health Infrastructure has engaged Richard Crookes Constructions to undertake the main works for the Cowra Hospital Redevelopment.

We recognise that building new infrastructure can impact nearby residents, patients, staff and road users. All construction activities will be carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

Road closures affecting vehicles and pedestrian access and water pressure impacts.

The following works notification details three areas requiring changes to traffic and pedestrian conditions, alongside the supply of water to be temporarily impacted and include:

- **10-14 June 2024: Ina Drive** (between Liverpool Street and Oscar Street) open for pedestrian and Emergency Department vehicular access only.
- **14 June-9 August 2024: Ina Drive** (between Oscar Street and Carleton Street) closed to pedestrians and reduced to one way for vehicles travelling south down the hill towards Oscar Street.
- **17-26 June 2024: Brisbane Street** (loading dock access) pedestrian access and traffic management in place.



For your safety, please follow the directions of signage and traffic controllers when in place at all times.

10-14 June 2024: Ina Drive (between Liverpool Street and Oscar Street) open for pedestrian and Emergency Department vehicular access only.

In order to undertake sewer connection works, Ina Drive, between Liverpool Street and Oscar Street will be open for Emergency Department access (Ambulance and emergency patient drop off) only, accessible only from Liverpool Street, between 10-14 June 2024. Alternate vehicle access during this time to Carleton and Upper Ina Drive will be via Darling Street. Pedestrian access will be maintained during this time.

14 June 2024 – 9 August 2024: Ina Drive (between Oscar Street and Carleton Street) closed to vehicles and pedestrians.

In order to install kerb barriers, Ina Drive will be closed to pedestrians (between Oscar Street and Carleton Street) and vehicles will be restricted to one way, travelling south down the hill from Carleton St towards Oscar St.

Access to the Emergency Department for Ambulances and emergency patient drop off be via Liverpool Street only. Alternate vehicle access during this time to Carleton and Upper Ina Drive will be via Darling Street.

17-26 June 2024: Brisbane Street pedestrian access and traffic management.

In order to manage the stormwater during construction as well as being the permanent stormwater infrastructure for the new Hospital, work will be undertaken at the back of house loading dock and existing driveway off Brisbane Street which will require modified pedestrian access and traffic management. The work will require closure of the loading dock and alternate deliveries have been scheduled with the Cowra Health Service.

Traffic management will be in place on Brisbane Street to manage the flow of construction vehicles and Brisbane Street traffic.

14 June 2024 - Water pressure and water flow temporarily impacted.

In order to undertake work to the existing watermain on Brisbane Street, the supply of water to the surrounding community may be temporarily affected resulting in low flow and/or low pressure. Where possible it is advised to limit water use on 14 June 2024.

The water supply to the Cowra Health Service will not be affected.

How will the work affect you?

Please be advised some noisy works will be required including saw-cutting and demolition of concrete. These works will only be undertaken between the hours of 9.00am-12.00pm and 2.00pm-5.00pm which is in accordance with the approved planning approval mitigation measures.

The works times will be between 7.00am and 6.00pm from Monday to Friday and 8.00am to 1.00pm on Saturday with no work on Sunday or Public Holidays. We will let you know in advance of any changes to these days and times.
